Verses you are encouraged to memorize for the month of October: Mark 1:14-15; 2:17; 12:29-31.

Mark 1:14–15 (NIV84) — **14** After John was put in prison, Jesus went into Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God. **15** “The time has come,” he said. “The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!”

Mark 2:17 (NIV84) — **17** On hearing this, Jesus said to them, “It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.”

Mark 12:29–31 (NIV84) — **29** “The most important one,” answered Jesus, “is this: ‘Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. **30** Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.’ **31** The second is this: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no commandment greater than these.”
