



## Leviticus: Be Holy

### Week 2: Leviticus 8 – 10 “The Kingdom of Priests”

#### Read Leviticus 8

1. Moses performed the ordination ceremony for Aaron and his sons because it was what the LORD commanded Moses to do. What stands out to you in the ordination ceremony? What do you think is the significance of the water, oil, and blood in this ceremony?
2. What sacrifices were performed on the day of Aaron and his son's ordination, and what do you learn about God as you consider the order of the sacrifices? (Lev. 8)
3. In Lev. 8:31-36 Moses gives instructions to Aaron and his sons as the LORD commanded him to do. What do you learn about God from these instructions? How important was it for Aaron and his sons to do exactly as the LORD commanded? As you consider your own obedience to God and what He expects from you, which areas do you need to evaluate and change?

#### Read Leviticus 9

4. In Lev. 9 Aaron's official service begins, which offerings are Aaron required to perform on his own behalf and what offerings are completed on behalf of the people? What do you learn about how approaching a holy God from these practices?
5. How does God appear to the people that day? How did the people respond? How do you respond when you see evidence of God?

#### Read Leviticus 10

6. What was the result of Nadab and Abihu's act of offering unauthorized fire before the LORD? Why was the penalty so severe?
7. As you ponder Leviticus 8 – 10 this week, what do you think about the sacrificial system that points to Christ, what have you learned about God and how will that change the way you live your life this week?
